<u>Lagoon</u>: The lagoon is finally done with the exception of some lighting which we are still making final adjustments on. The three (3) fountains are on timers and are scheduled to turn on every morning at 7am and off every evening at 11pm. The landscape lights will turn on at sunset every day and will turn off at midnight.

<u>L&R Office</u>: The L&R Office is open for business. Thank you for your patience in this project.

<u>New Pool Furniture</u>: The majority of furniture for Cabrillo and Roeder pools has been received but six (6) umbrellas are yet to be received.

Parking: Due to the Coronado Shores Construction Moratorium there will be no parking for contractors inside the community from Monday, June 17th until Labor Day. Also, the summer parking ban for employees and service care providers begins on Monday, June 24th until Labor Day. Violations will be written for infractions. Vehicles may also be booted or towed in accordance with our Rules and Regulations.

Parking Pass System: Each visiting vehicle entering the Shore's property must first stop at the kiosk to get their parking pass. The process starts with the resident notifying their respective Doorperson, who will then notify the kiosk for proper input into the system. Sometimes, when a visitor arrives there is no data in the system and it causes a delay when the security officer has to call the building or the resident to verify entry. Please assist us with this process. There is a maximum of 30 days for a temporary parking pass. Please refer to the current edition of the Rules and Regulations for more information.


